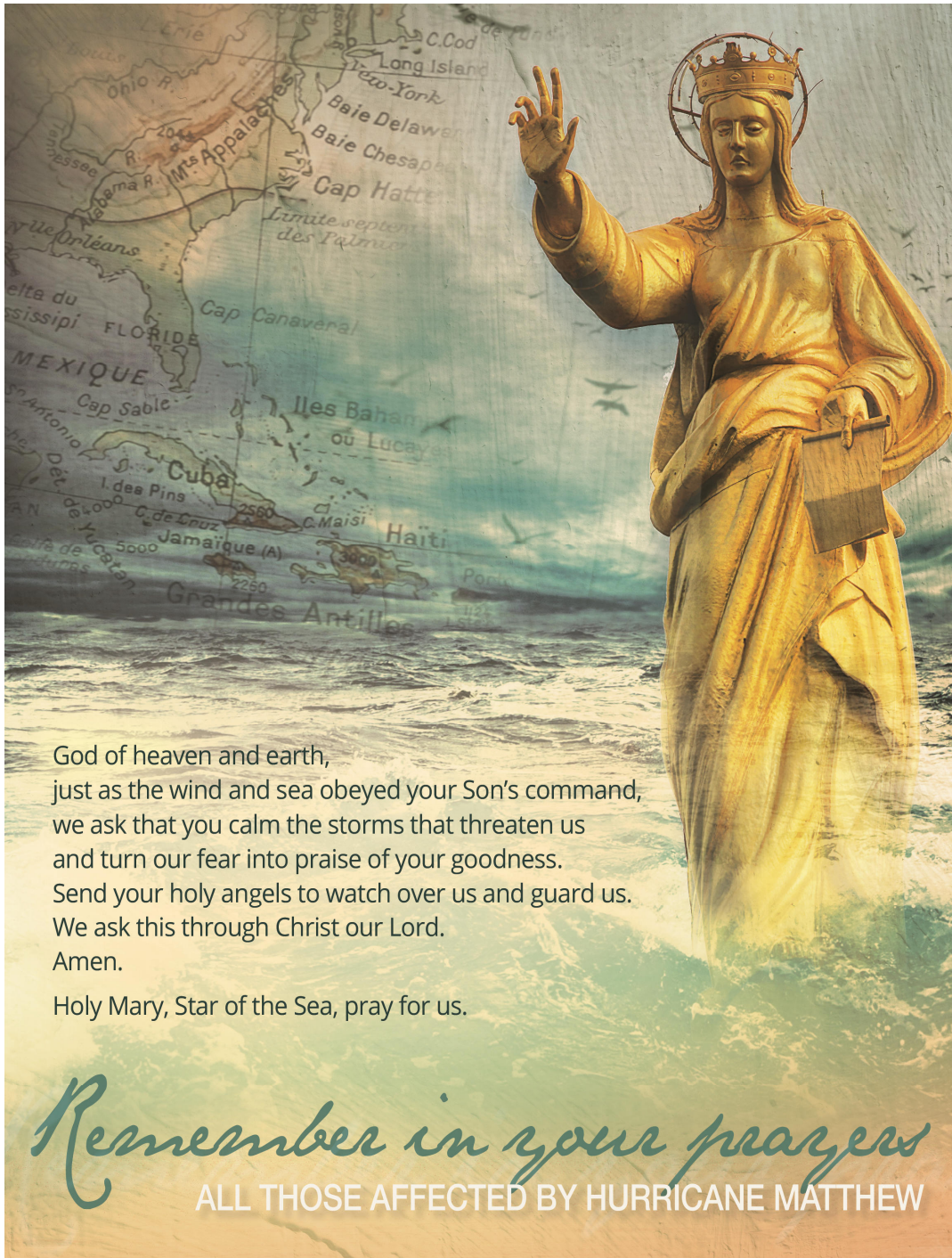

ADORATION NOTES



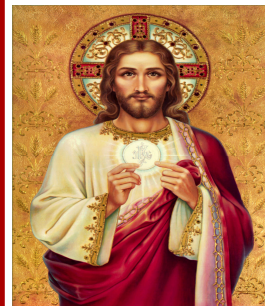

Cheryl and Nick* had good jobs, a nice home, and each other. They wanted to share their blessings and thought foster parenting was a good way to help a child and complete their family. Catholic Charities walked them through the steps of welcoming a foster child, from the

state application process to the emotional preparation. Having fostered several children now, they are grateful for the training from Catholic Charities. They say they learned an important lesson that increases their joy: fostering is not about serving a personal need, but serving the need of a child.

In 2015, Catholic Charities agencies provided foster care services for 4,766 children and adolescents.
