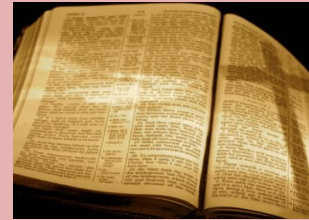

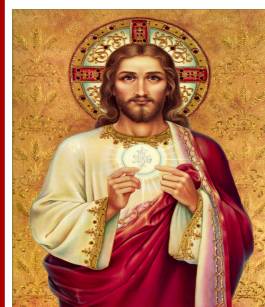


## ADORATION NOTES

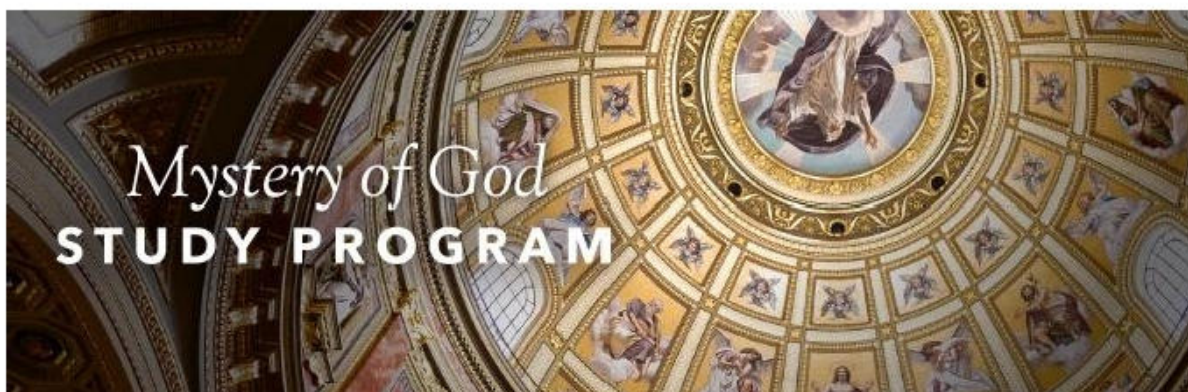
