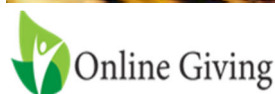

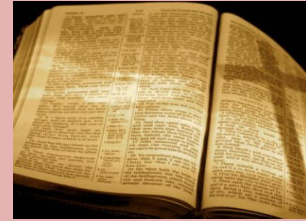

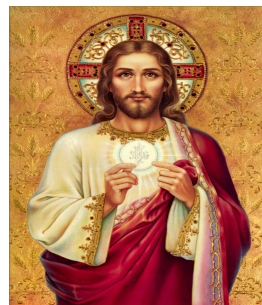
### ADORATION NOTES
