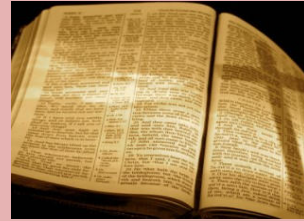

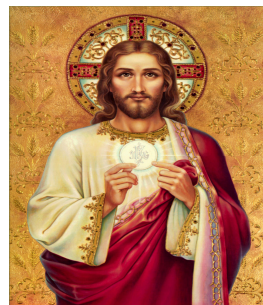


ADORATION NOTES
