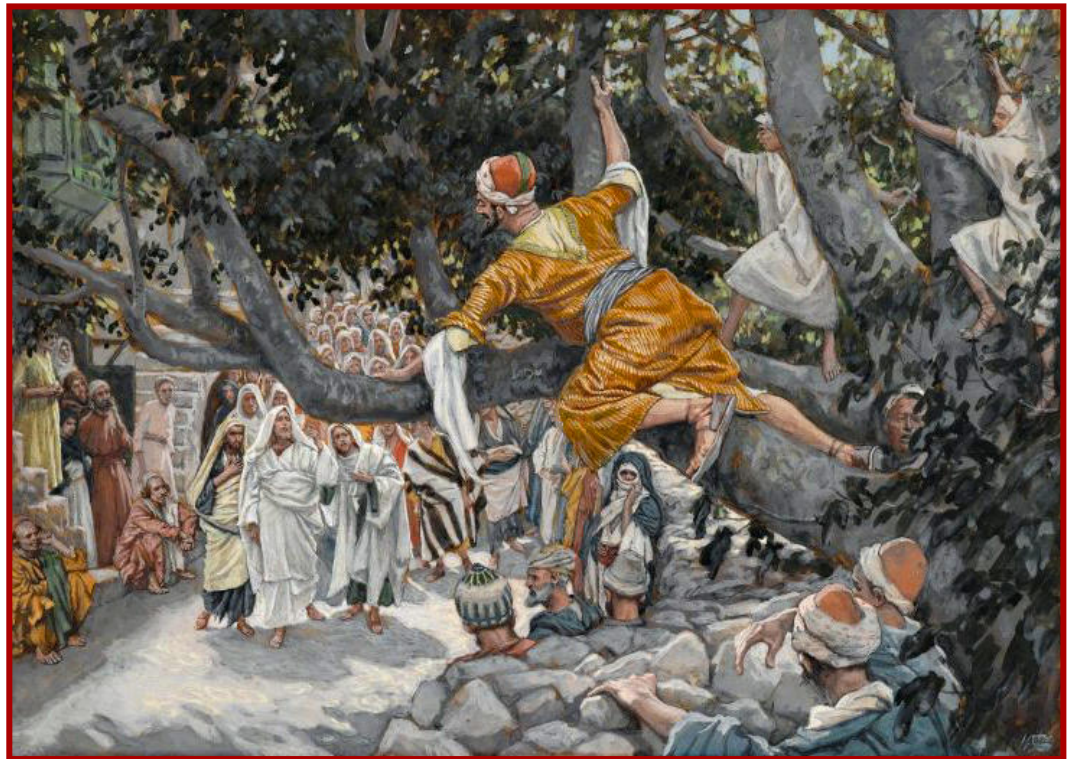

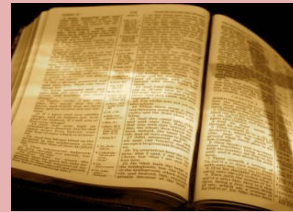
WITH SYMPATHY

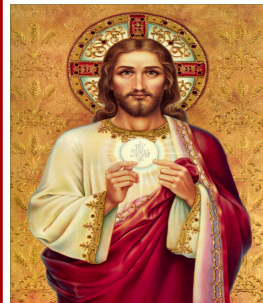


ADORATION NOTES

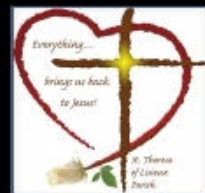
